A 288-fiber optic cable contains 288 individual optical fibers bundled together, designed for high-capacity backbone networks, data centers, and metropolitan deployments.

Overview and Construction

A 288-fiber optic cable is a high-density cable that consolidates 288 individual fibers within a single protective sheath, allowing for massive bandwidth and scalability . These fibers are typically organized into subunits, such as loose tubes or ribbons, often with 12 fibers per ribbon, which simplifies splicing, identification, and maintenance . The cable construction usually includes:

- o Strength members (e.g., aramid yarns) for tensile support
- o Water-blocking materials to prevent moisture ingress
- o Durable outer jackets made from polyethylene or LSZH compounds for outdoor or indoor use
- o All-dielectric design in some models, eliminating the need for grounding

Types and Variants

- o Loose Tube Gel-Free Cables: Flexible, water-blocked tubes that isolate fibers from environmental stress and allow easy mid-span access .
- o Ribbonized Indoor Cables: Fibers arranged in ribbons for mass fusion splicing, ideal for data center distribution with MPO-style connectors .
- o Outdoor Multi-Loose Tube Cables: Designed for ducts, tunnels, or direct burial, often with 12 tubes x 24 fibers configuration .

Applications

288-fiber cables are used in large-scale network deployments where high capacity and future-proofing are critical:

- o Telecom and ISP backbones for metropolitan or campus networks
- o Data center interconnects and high-density distribution
- o Industrial, cable TV, and broadcast networks requiring robust outdoor installation
