These gels seal the box against water, dust, and solids, preventing short circuits and protecting internal connections. They are especially useful for junction boxes exposed to rain or high humidity.

Material Compatibility

- o Plastic Boxes: Lightweight and cost-effective; adhesives like Tecbond 238 bond well to PVC or ABS enclosures .
- o Steel or Stainless Steel Boxes: Require high-strength construction adhesives (Tecbond 280) for secure mounting .
- o Fiberglass or Polycarbonate: Use adhesives compatible with composite materials; waterproof gels can also provide additional sealing .

Installation Tips

- o Ensure the surface is clean, dry, and free of dust or grease before applying adhesive.
- o Apply adhesive evenly along the mounting surface or inside the box edges for maximum contact.
- o For waterproof gels, mix components thoroughly (if two-part) and pour carefully to cover all connection points .
- o Allow sufficient curing time as specified by the adhesive manufacturer before energizing the system.
- o Always follow IP or NEMA rating requirements to maintain protection against water and dust ingress .

Safety Considerations

- o Use adhesives that are non-conductive and rated for electrical applications.
- o Avoid overloading the adhesive with heavy boxes; combine with mechanical supports if necessary.
