Connector Types

- o Multimode Fiber (MM): Larger core (50-62.5um), supports multiple light modes, suitable for short-distance, high-bandwidth applications. Variants include OM1 (orange), OM2 (orange), OM3 (aqua), OM4 (violet), and OM5 (lime green) .

Cable Configurations

Patch cords can be simplex or duplex:

- o Simplex: Single fiber, used for one-way transmission .
- o Duplex: Two fibers, typically used for bidirectional communication, often paired with LC or SC connectors .

Jacket Types and Applications

The outer jacket material affects installation and safety:

- o PVC: Standard indoor use, basic protection .

- o Plenum (OFNP): Fire-resistant, suitable for air ducts .
- o Riser (OFNR): For vertical shafts between floors .
- o LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen): Emits minimal smoke/toxic gas, common in Europe and high-safety areas .

- o Bend-Insensitive Fiber: Reduces signal loss in tight bends, ideal for FTTH and high-density racks .
- o Indoor/Outdoor Hybrid Cables: Designed for transitions between outside plant and indoor equipment .
- o High-Density Breakout Cables: MPO/MTP to LC/SC breakouts for 40G/100G/400G data center links .
