

Are fiber optic cables restricted in Yemen

Preview

The dispute between the state-owned telecommunication companies, TeleYemen in Sana'a and TeleYemen in Aden, has prevented the activation or the use of the cable which would provide the Internet with a high amount of bandwidth. Yemen's bandwidth is dominated by a single aging subsea cable, the FALCON/FLAG system, landing at the Red Sea port of Hodeidah, with only a narrow backup via Djibouti and some satellite links. During the civil war, land fiber links to Saudi Arabia were destroyed, leaving Yemen largely dependent on. Multiple reports say several subsea fiber-optic cables in the Red Sea and southern Red Sea near Yemen were severed or damaged, disrupting internet traffic across parts of the Middle East, South Asia and East Africa, and fueling finger-pointing at Yemen's Iran-aligned Houthi rebels even as. The severing of the SEA-ME-WE 4, IMEWE, and FALCON GCX subsea cables near Saudi Arabia has caused Internet issues in the Middle East and South Asia. The cause of the Red Sea cuts is not yet known. Houthi rebels have previously been accused of attacking cables, but the area is also a busy shipping. DUBAI, United Arab Emirates (AP) -- Undersea cable cuts in the Red Sea disrupted internet access in parts of Asia and the Middle East, experts said Sunday, though it wasn't immediately clear what caused the incident. However, it is still unclear the extent of the damage and how long it may take to restore the service. The Red Sea hosts more than 15 such sub-sea cables responsible for connecting Europe and Asia, carrying 80 percent of Asia's westward traffic.
