The NEC requirement for splicing cables and conductors installed in cable trays is stated in Sec. To properly bond Hubbell (R) painted cable tray, remove the plastic masking device from the trays on each end (exposing the pre-galvanized wire), and splice sections. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
