Common Bracket Styles

This method is particularly effective for long horizontal runs . **Surface-Mounted Fixing:** Brackets or clips attach trays directly to surfaces, often used for heavy-duty or industrial installations where trays must remain accessible .

Specialized Bracket Types

Stand-Off Brackets: Provide clearance between the tray and wall or surface, available in sizes from 50mm to 300mm. They are ideal for installations requiring airflow or cable separation . **G Hanger Support Brackets:** Designed for overhead support of trays or baskets, typically available in 100mm and 150mm sizes, offering strong support for suspended runs . **Trapeze Support Brackets:** Pre-assembled for quick installation, these brackets support wide trays with various drop lengths, commonly used in industrial or commercial applications for heavy cable loads .

Materials and Durability

Brackets are commonly made from pre-galvanized steel, hot-dipped galvanized steel, or stainless steel (A316/A4), ensuring corrosion resistance and long-term durability. Selection depends on environmental conditions and load requirements .
