Yes, a Layer 2 switch can support VLANs by segmenting a physical network into multiple virtual networks, creating isolated broadcast domains. It reduces unnecessary broadcast traffic, enhances security, and improves network. All documentation I read advises not to have a VLAN span across more than one Access layer switch, and they always add the *if possible to the end of that statement. Avoid unmanaged and "smart" Lite switches, as they restrict access control list (ACL) customization and advanced. End devices connect to access ports (switchport access vlan X). Access switches connect upstream using 802.1Q trunks, carrying many VLANs. Layer 3 lives in the distribution or core, usually via SVIs and a FHRP (HSRP/VRRP/GLBP).
