- o Automation Frameworks: Open-source tools like Ansible can be integrated with a backend system (e.g., Flask with SQLite) to automate configuration management, monitoring, and SSH-based secure access for Cisco or other vendor switches .
- o Hybrid Approaches: Combining vendor platforms with automation scripts allows for both centralized control and flexibility in multi-vendor environments, supporting analytics, reporting, and future integration with additional network devices .

Best Practices

- o Pre-configure SSH or management access on all switches before centralization to ensure secure connectivity .
- o Segment management traffic from regular network traffic to enhance security and reduce congestion.
- o Regularly audit configurations and use version control to track changes.
- o Leverage redundancy and high availability in both the core switches and the management platform to prevent single points of failure .
