

Change the gray cable tray to white

Add view filters for the different cable trays -> Add the filter in the view -> Set the surface pattern as Solid Fill and set the color. Also the question is, how do you change the color of a model in Revit? Go to File in the top left. Click Options in the bottom right. I have several filters setup for cable tray colors and voltage levels. When i move or edit a cable tray Revit changes the parts of the cable tray i move in the model, back to color (white) from whatever color the filter is set. Changing the color of a cable tray in Revit requires a systematic approach to modify the appearance of the element within the project. For fittings I filter them to be solid fill white and put the filter above the others in the list so it overrides them. You could use the Type Name as an alternative but that's the way I started so that's what I
