A 1U chassis occupies 1.75 inches (44.45 mm) in height and is designed to fit into a 19-inch rack, which is the global standard for IT equipment . The width is fixed at 19 inches, while the depth can vary; in this case, the 800mm depth provides sufficient space for most network switches, patch panels, and shallow servers . Ukrainian 1U chassis typically follow EIA-310 standards, ensuring compatibility with international rack systems .

- o 800mm depth is considered moderate, allowing for standard cabling and equipment installation without excessive strain on cables .
- o Deeper racks (1000mm+) are often recommended for high-density servers or GPU systems to improve airflow and accommodate longer cables .
