Safety First

Before inspecting, ensure the power is turned off if possible, and always use personal protective equipment such as insulated gloves and safety glasses to prevent electrocution or burns. Avoid touching live components unless you are trained and equipped to do so .

Visual Inspection

- o Check for dust, debris, and corrosion inside the enclosure, as these can cause overheating or short circuits .
- o Inspect wiring for damage such as burnt insulation, fraying, or discoloration .
- o Verify that all connections are tight and secure, including terminals and busbars .
- o Look for signs of overheating or rust on breakers and panel components .
- o Ensure proper labeling of circuits and safety signs to reduce misuse .

Functional Checks

- o Test circuit breakers to ensure they operate correctly under load conditions .
- o Measure voltage levels at key points to confirm proper distribution .
- o Check grounding and bonding for continuity and resistance to ensure safety .

Documentation

- o Update maintenance logs with dates and details for future reference .
- o Schedule the next inspection based on observed conditions .
