Overview

A distribution box is an enclosure that houses electrical components for power and signal distribution, providing protection, organization, and modularity for electrical installations. When equipped with a magnetic switch, the box can be turned on or off without direct mechanical contact, enhancing safety and convenience, especially in automation or remote-controlled systems .

Functionality of Magnetic Switches

Magnetic switches, also known as reed switches or magnetic actuators, operate when a magnet is brought close to the switch. In distribution boxes, this allows:

- o Safe ON/OFF control without opening the enclosure.
- o Integration with smart systems for remote or automated switching.
- o Protection against accidental activation, as the switch only responds to the correct magnetic key . For example, the Jeti Central Box 210 uses a magnetic switch to power the unit on or off. The supplied magnet must be held near the switch in the correct orientation to activate it. This system supports battery redundancy and safe power management for connected devices .
