High-density racks may have PDUs with up to 60 outlets to support 45U or taller cabinets .

Redundancy and Safety

Many network cabinets include dual PDUs to provide redundant power, ensuring that critical devices remain operational even if one circuit fails . Proper cable management and grounding are essential to maintain electrical safety and airflow efficiency within the cabinet . Intelligent PDUs often include locking outlets to prevent accidental disconnection of devices .
