

Does fiber optic broadband include a router

How Fiber Internet Works

Fiber internet uses an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) instead of a traditional modem. The ONT converts light signals from the fiber optic cable into digital data that your devices can use . This device is essential for connecting your home to the ISP's network, but it does not provide Wi-Fi or network distribution on its own .

Router Requirements

To share the fiber connection across multiple devices, a router is required. The router connects to the ONT via an Ethernet cable and distributes the internet either wirelessly (Wi-Fi) or through wired connections . Most ISPs allow you to rent or purchase a fiber-ready router, and some offer all-in-one devices that combine the ONT and router in a single unit for convenience .

Choosing a Router

When selecting a router for fiber internet, consider:

- o Gigabit support to handle high-speed fiber connections .
- o Dual-band or tri-band Wi-Fi to reduce interference and improve coverage .
- o Quality of Service (QoS) features to prioritize critical traffic like video calls or gaming .
- o Advanced security such as firewalls and VPN support . For larger homes, mesh Wi-Fi systems can be added to extend coverage and eliminate dead zones .
