Bending Losses: Sharp bends in the fiber can cause light to escape. Distance Limitation: Without amplification, the signal weakens significantly over distance, making it difficult to detect at the receiver. Typical fiber loss is around 0.2 dB/km (decibels per kilometer), but it can vary. Such repeaters are used to extend the reach of optical communications links by overcoming loss due to attenuation of the optical fiber.
