Many clamps include rubber pads or V-grooves to hold the cable buffer without damaging the fiber . Some advanced clamps feature adjustable magnetic or screw mechanisms to fine-tune clamping force for precision applications .

- o Correct Sizing: Choose a clamp that matches the cable diameter to prevent damage and ensure secure holding .
- o Proper Tension: For aerial installations, tension clamps must maintain the correct cable tension to avoid

- o Inspection: After installation, inspect clamps and cables for secure positioning and absence of damage .
