Attach the fiber patch cable from the ONT to the wall-mounted router or enclosure. Ensure the connectors are clean and properly seated. For GPON networks, SC/APC connectors (green) are standard . After connecting, power on the router and verify the light levels are within the recommended range (-8 dBm to -27 dBm for GPON), .

## Step 7: Test and Optimize

Check the fiber connection speed and Wi-Fi coverage. Ensure all devices can connect successfully. For advanced setups, configure VLANs, QoS, or integrate with existing network infrastructure if needed . Label cables and note installation dates for future maintenance.

Always wear safety glasses when handling fiber to prevent eye injury from laser light or fiber splinters. Dispose of fiber scraps safely. Schedule periodic inspections with an OTDR to detect micro-bends or signal degradation .
