Fiber optic cables range from \$0.09 to \$6 per foot depending on type, strand count, and installation requirements, with single-mode and multimode options for indoor and outdoor use.

Fiber Optic Cable Types

1. Single-Mode Fiber (OS1, OS2)

- o Core diameter: ~8-10 microns
- o Best for long-distance communication (up to 100 km)
- o Low signal loss, ideal for campus backbones, metropolitan networks, and long-haul applications
- o OS1: Indoor tight-buffered construction
- o OS2: Outdoor loose-tube construction

o Price: \$0.10-\$0.50 per foot for the cable itself; pre-terminated assemblies cost more 2. Multimode Fiber (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4)

- o Core diameter: 50-62.5 microns
- o Suitable for shorter distances, in-building cabling, and high-speed network installations
- o OM3/OM4 optimized for 10-100 Gbps networks
- o Price: \$0.30-\$1.00 per foot; higher strand counts increase cost proportionally 3. Specialty Fibers

- o G.652.D, G.655, G.657.A1, G.657.A2 for FTTX and access networks
- o Indoor cables: White or yellow coating
- o Outdoor cables: Black coating, water-resistant, LSZH or PE jackets
- o Equipped with FRP elements for tensile strength and bending radius protection

Cable Construction and Ratings

- o Indoor vs Outdoor: Outdoor cables are often armored and weather-resistant, increasing cost
- o Armored Cables: \$0.50-\$5 per foot, suitable for direct burial or harsh environments
- o Jacket Materials: LSZH (low smoke zero halogen) for fire safety, PVC or PE for standard protection
- o Fiber Count: 1-288 strands; higher counts increase price significantly

- o Wholesale bulk: \$0.09-\$1.52
- o Retail: \$1-\$6 depending on fiber type, strand count, and jacket Installation Costs

- o Labor: \$0.60-\$3.00 per foot depending on terrain and complexity
- o Permits: \$150-\$900 depending on region
- o Accessories (connectors, patch panels, adapters): \$100-\$350

Connectors and Pre-Terminated Assemblies

- o Common connectors: LC, SC, ST, MTP/MPO
- o Pre-terminated patch cables cost more due to factory termination
- o Connector type affects compatibility and price

Summary

Fiber optic cables vary widely in type, strand count, jacket material, and installation complexity, which directly affects pricing. Single-mode is preferred for long distances, multimode for shorter runs. Indoor cables are cheaper than outdoor or armored variants. For budgeting, expect \$0.10-\$6 per foot for materials, with total installed costs ranging from a few thousand dollars for small indoor runs to over \$14,000 for large outdoor projects with armored cables and multiple splices.
