## Overview of LC Connector

The LC connector is a miniaturized version of the SC connector, designed with a 1.25mm ferrule, which is half the size of the SC connector's 2.5mm ferrule . Its compact form factor makes it perfect for high-density patch panels, data centers, and modern optical transceivers. The LC uses a latch mechanism similar to an RJ45 plug, providing secure connections in tight spaces while maintaining low insertion loss and high return loss .

## Comparison with Other Connectors

- o SC Connector: Larger 2.5mm ferrule, square push-pull design, widely used in FTTH and legacy networks .
- o ST Connector: Bayonet-style twist-lock, older design, larger footprint, mainly for industrial or legacy systems .
- o FC Connector: Threaded circular design, precise alignment, larger than LC, used in high-vibration environments .

  - o Duplex and simplex support: Can handle both single and dual fiber connections efficiently.
