Openings for cables or ventilation are sealed with fire-stopping materials to maintain the integrity of the fire barrier .

Additional Fire Prevention Measures

- o Oil-filled equipment like transformers should be installed with partitions on both sides, and if the oil volume exceeds certain thresholds, additional containment or explosion-proof rooms are required .
- o Electrical rooms are often constructed with fire-resistant walls, ceilings, and doors to contain fires for a defined period, typically one to two hours .
- o Fire-fighting equipment should be available in the distribution room, and proper spacing between high and low voltage devices is recommended to reduce fire risk .
