- o Sealing and Tamper-Proof Features: Ensure integrity of billing and prevent unauthorized access .

Electricity enters the box after being measured and is then distributed to multiple branch circuits for lighting, appliances, and equipment. It is typically located indoors or in accessible service rooms to allow routine operation, maintenance, and inspection .
