

# Height Regulations for Electric Wires and Optical Cables

## Preview

The National Electrical Safety Code, published by the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, sets clearances ranging from as low as 10 feet for certain residential service drops up to more than 40 feet above large navigable waterways. All conductors of outside wiring shall comply with clearances specified in Rule 37, General Order No. 95, 1981 Edition, Rules for Overhead Electric Line Construction of the California Public Utilities Commission, which is hereby incorporated by reference. The height above ground of any wire or cable which is attached to a support carrying any overhead line shall not be less than 5.8 metres at any point where it is over a road accessible to vehicular traffic.

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The section outlines the required clearances for overhead conductors and cables with a nominal voltage of up to 1000 volts. Specific height requirements vary based on the location and voltage level.

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
