Adequate clearance in front of the panel (minimum 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high) is required for safe operation and maintenance . Panels must also comply with UL, CE, or IEC standards, depending on the region .

Enclosure and Protection

High-end residential panels use steel or high-quality plastic enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings for protection against dust, moisture, and impact . Proper ventilation and spacing inside the box prevent overheating and allow safe wiring management .
