

How high are electrical distribution boxes in Bulgaria off the ground

Residential: The recommended height for distribution board and consumer unit is between 1 metre to 1.3 metres for elderly and handicapped people in the residential unit. This keeps them safe from water and dirt. Select a well-ventilated and dry place to avoid poor heat dissipation causing equipment. 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Install a distribution box at 4.5 to 5.5 feet high for safety, accessibility, and compliance. This height ensures easy use and protection from hazards.

For the vertical clearance, often called headroom, the space must be clear from the floor up to a minimum height of 6 feet 7 inches (2.0 meters) or the height of the equipment, whichever is
