QSFP28 LR4 is an optical transceiver module that provides high-speed data communication through fiber optic cables. This device is designed to transmit and receive 100 Gigabit Ethernet (100GbE) signals and is commonly used for high-speed interconnects in data centers and telecommunication networks. QSFP+ (Quad Small Form-Factor Pluggable Plus) is the workhorse optical form factor for 40 GbE compact, hot-pluggable, and built around 4x10 Gb/s electrical lanes per direction.
