These boxes often include features like fusion splice trays, SC/LC adapters, bend-radius protection, and slack cable storage to ensure efficient fiber management and minimal signal loss . When selecting an optical distribution box, it is important to consider the current network size, expected growth, and environmental conditions. Indoor boxes typically use ABS or ABS+PC materials, while outdoor boxes may require higher IP ratings and rugged construction to withstand dust, water, and mechanical stress . In summary, while 4 to 16 ports are typical for standard deployments, high-density or modular boxes can accommodate up to 96 ports or more, allowing network designers to scale efficiently without frequent hardware replacement .
