

How many sockets should be left in a home electrical distribution box

Preview

At least one socket-outlets circuit rated 16 A (rating according to National socket-outlet system), each circuit supplying a reasonable number of socket-outlets in series, taking into account the wiring cross-section area used (1.5 mm²), the wiring lengths. Whilst there is no legal requirement for a minimum number of electrical outlets in the wiring regulations or building regulations, there is a recommended minimum depending upon the size of the room. An increased number of socket outlets will mean less reliance on extension leads reducing the risk. These state that wherever mobile equipment is used, it should be "fed from an adjacent and conveniently accessible socket outlet, taking account of the length of flexible cable normally fitted to portable appliances and luminaires".
