Factors Affecting Cost

- o **Sensor Type:** Fluorescence sensors are cost-effective for localized measurements, FBG sensors balance cost and precision, and DTS systems are premium solutions for long-distance monitoring.
- o **Accuracy and Response Time:** High-accuracy sensors ($\pm 0.1^{\circ}\text{C}$) and fast-response sensors command higher prices than standard sensors ($\pm 1.0^{\circ}\text{C}$).
- o **Temperature Range:** Sensors designed for extreme temperatures (e.g., -270°C to $+600^{\circ}\text{C}$) are significantly more expensive than standard industrial ranges (-40°C to $+150^{\circ}\text{C}$).
- o **Environmental Durability:** Sensors with protective coatings or materials for harsh environments (chemical, high humidity, or corrosive conditions) increase costs.
- o **System Components:** Total cost may include interrogators, transmitters, cabling, and software, which are essential for data acquisition and monitoring.
- o **Quantity and Import Costs:** Bulk orders may reduce per-unit cost, but shipping and tariffs to Samoa could add to the final price.

Practical Considerations

For procurement in Samoa, it is important to consider shipping, import duties, and local technical support. While the sensor itself may cost a few hundred to a few thousand dollars, a complete system with multiple sensors and monitoring equipment could exceed \$10,000, especially for distributed sensing applications. Evaluating the total system value, including reliability, long-term performance, and reduced maintenance, is crucial for cost-effectiveness.
