

How to connect fiber optic cables to the fiber optic cable tray

Preparation and Tools

- o Ladder trays are better for heavy backbone cables over long distances, but ensure rungs are close enough to prevent sagging ().

Installing and Routing Cables

- o Respect the bend radius: Maintain at least 20 times the cable diameter during pulling and 10 times when static in the tray to prevent micro-cracks in the fiber ().
- o Pull by strength members: Use aramid yarn or central rods, not the fiber itself, to avoid breakage ().
- o Use figure-8 or loop techniques for long pulls to reduce stress.
- o Secure cables with UV-resistant cable ties, ensuring they are snug but not overly tight.
- o Maintain polarity and labeling according to TIA-606-C standards for easy identification and troubleshooting ().

Connecting and Splicing

- o Splice trays are used to organize and protect fiber splices. Prepare fibers by stripping, cleaning, and cleaving before fusion splicing ().
- o Fusion splicing provides low-loss, permanent connections. Place spliced fibers carefully in the tray, ensuring no sharp bends.
- o Mechanical connectors can be used for temporary or modular connections, but must also respect bend radius and strain limits.
