

How to connect multiple switches using fiber optic cable

Use duplex fiber optic cables with compatible SFP/SFP+ modules to interconnect switches, ensuring proper topology and redundancy.

Choosing the Right Fiber and SFP Modules

To connect multiple switches, select duplex fiber optic cables (two strands per connection) or higher strand counts for multiple links. The type of fiber--single-mode (OS2) or multimode (OM3/OM4)--depends on the distance between switches. For short distances (under 300 meters), multimode fiber is typically sufficient, while single-mode is preferred for longer runs. Each switch must have SFP or SFP+ transceiver modules compatible with the fiber type and network speed. For example, 1G connections use SFP, 10G connections use SFP+, and higher bandwidths may require QSFP modules. Ensure the SFP module matches the switch's port bandwidth.

Cabling and Connectors

Fiber cables should be terminated with LC connectors, which are standard for most SFP modules. Pre-terminated fiber cables save installation time and reduce errors. When connecting two switches, the send and receive strands must be crossed (A to B, B to A) to ensure proper communication.

Network Topology and Redundancy

Common topologies include star and daisy chain. A star topology connects all switches to a central switch, while a daisy chain links switches sequentially. For redundancy, avoid simple loops that can cause broadcast storms. Instead, use EtherChannel or link aggregation to combine multiple fiber links between switches, providing failover without creating loops. For example, if each floor has one switch, run two fiber cables per switch and configure them as a Layer 2 EtherChannel. This setup ensures redundancy: if one fiber fails, the other maintains connectivity.

Installation Tips

- o Verify fiber type and SFP compatibility before installation.
- o Use pre-terminated cables to reduce labor and errors.
- o Label each fiber strand to simplify troubleshooting.
- o Test each link with a fiber tester to ensure low attenuation and proper signal transmission.
- o Configure switch ports for the correct speed and duplex settings, and enable link aggregation if using multiple fibers for redundancy. By following these guidelines, you can connect multiple switches efficiently.
