

How to install handles on household electrical distribution boxes

- o **Optional Locking Feature:** Some handles include a lock for added security. Install the lock cylinder according to the manufacturer's instructions.

- o Avoid over-tightening screws, which can deform the panel or damage insulation.
- o Periodically inspect the handle for wear or loosening, especially in high-use areas.
