

How to set the voltage on a fiber optic switch

Article Overview

Fiber optic switches typically operate at a fixed supply voltage, often 5V for TTL interfaces, and voltage adjustments are generally not required or recommended.

Understanding Voltage Requirements

Most fiber optic switches, such as the LEONI EOL series, are designed to operate with a standard positive voltage of 5V, which serves as the reference for all interface signals including serial and parallel control lines . The voltage is used to power the internal optomechanical components and to provide logic levels for TTL-compatible control signals. Attempting to exceed or reduce this voltage can damage the switch or cause unreliable operation.

Electrical Interface Considerations

- o TTL Logic Levels: Control inputs (DATA0..3, strobe, clock) operate at TTL levels referenced to the 5V supply. Ensure that any connected controller or microcontroller matches these voltage levels .
- o I2C Interface: For switches with I2C control, the interface also uses standard 5V logic. The switch can be addressed and controlled via I2C commands without modifying the supply voltage .
- o Power Supply: Use a regulated 5V power source capable of supplying the current specified in the switch datasheet. Avoid connecting the supply to GND or other pins not intended for power .

Monitoring and Safety

For switches integrated with SFP modules or other optical transceivers, the operating voltage of the module can be monitored via the switch CLI using commands like `show fiber-ports-optical-transceiver` on Cisco devices. This displays the SFP operating voltage, current, and optical power, helping ensure the module is within safe operating limits . **Safety Note:** Never attempt to manually adjust the voltage on fiber optic modules or switches beyond the manufacturer's specifications. Exposure to incorrect voltage can damage the device and may pose a risk of electrical or optical hazards .

Practical Recommendation

- o Do not manually set or adjust voltage unless the switch documentation explicitly provides a procedure.
- o Use the recommended 5V supply for TTL-controlled switches.
- o Verify voltage and current through monitoring tools or CLI commands if available.
- o Ensure compatibility between the switch and any connected control electronics to prevent logic level mismatches. By following these guidelines, you can safely operate a fiber optic switch without the need for



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manual voltage adjustments, ensuring reliable switching and long-term device stability.
