

# How to set up a router for a 20m fiber optic connection

## Article Overview

To set up a router with a 20-meter fiber optic cable, connect the fiber to an ONT, then link the ONT to your router via Ethernet, and configure your network for optimal performance.

### Step 1: Gather Equipment

Ensure you have the following:

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber optic signals into electrical signals your router can use, usually provided by your ISP .
- o Fiber optic cable (20m): Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Router: Must support fiber input via WAN or SFP port.
- o Ethernet cable: To connect the ONT to the router.

### Step 2: Connect Fiber to ONT

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's line enters your home.

- o Power on the ONT and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize . Tip: Avoid bending the 20-meter fiber cable sharply; maintain gentle curves to prevent signal loss .

### Step 3: Link ONT to Router

- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port.
- o Power on the router and wait for indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .
- o For advanced setups, an SFP+ module may be used if your router supports multi-gigabit speeds .

### Step 4: Configure Router

- o Access the router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1).
- o Set up your Wi-Fi network, including SSID and password.
- o Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP or video conferencing to prioritize critical traffic .
- o Update firmware and check for optimal channel settings to maximize speed and coverage .

### Step 5: Placement and Cable Management

- o Place the router centrally and elevated to ensure even Wi-Fi coverage.
- o Keep the fiber cable away from sharp edges, heat sources, and electrical interference.
- o Ensure proper ventilation for both ONT and router to prevent overheating .

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## Step 6: Testing and Optimization

- o Verify internet speed and latency using online speed tests.
- o Check all devices can connect successfully.
- o Adjust router settings or reposition equipment if coverage or performance is suboptimal . By following these steps, your 20-meter fiber optic cable setup will deliver high-speed, low-latency internet with reliable connectivity throughout your home or office.
