

How to wire a Huijue rack splitter

- o Route cables neatly within the rack to prevent tangling and interference .
- o Use cable ties or Velcro straps to secure cables and maintain airflow. Leave at least 20% of rack space free for future expansion .
- o Label each cable and port for easier maintenance and troubleshooting .
