Level 3 distribution box inspections should cover physical integrity, electrical connections, grounding, protective devices, environmental protection, and documentation to ensure safe and reliable operation.

Physical and Structural Inspection

- o Check the enclosure for corrosion, rust, or physical damage and ensure it is securely mounted .
- o Verify that labels, warning signs, and color codes are legible and up to date .
- o Ensure ventilation openings are clear and free from dust or debris .
- o Inspect canopy protection, door locks, and rubber mats for safety compliance .

Internal Electrical Inspection

- o Open the box and check for dust, moisture, or debris accumulation .
- o Inspect circuit breakers, fuses, and contactors for proper operation and signs of overheating or arcing .
- o Verify that all connections are tight and secure, including incoming lines and branch circuits .
- o Check wiring insulation for damage or burn marks and ensure tidy routing inside ducting .
- o Test surge protection devices, RCDs, and GFCI protection for functionality .

Electrical Testing

- o Measure voltage levels and check for three-phase balance within $\pm 5\%$.
- o Perform insulation resistance testing on conductors .
- o Test grounding system continuity and resistance, ensuring no loose or corroded grounding wires .
- o Use thermal imaging to detect hot spots and check connector temperatures (
