A temperature transmitter is commonly used to convert the output signal from temperature sensors like RTDs (Resistance Temperature Detectors) or thermocouples into a standard 4-20 mA current signal that can be read by a PLC or control system. Analogue cable is installed in conjunction with an end-of-line (EOL) device for continuity monitoring and a modulator providing selectable alarm thresholds.
