

Installation method of fiberglass cable tray supports

Article Overview

Fiberglass cable trays (GRP/FRP) require careful planning, proper support, precise cutting, and secure fastening to ensure durability, safety, and corrosion resistance.

Planning and Site Preparation

Before installation, review construction drawings and conduct on-site inspections to determine the tray route, layer structure, installation height, and support spacing. Adjustments may be necessary for complex environments such as underground shafts, chemical equipment areas, or elevated supports. Pre-measure bends, ramps, and T-junctions to ensure proper alignment and load distribution. Verify that the tray's load-bearing capacity matches the cable quantity to prevent deformation or loosening during operation .

Cutting and Drilling Fiberglass Trays

Fiberglass is easy to work with using ordinary hand tools, but care is required to avoid damaging the resin. Use a circular power saw with an abrasive cut-off wheel or a hack saw with 24-32 teeth per inch. Drill using standard twist drills, similar to hardwood. Excessive pressure can dull tools and soften the resin, producing ragged edges. Seal any cut, drilled, or sanded surfaces with compatible resin to maintain structural integrity. For large-scale cutting, carbide-tipped saw blades and drill bits are recommended, and the material should be firmly supported to prevent chipping .

Support and Mounting

Support spacing should not exceed the distance between splice plates, and each tray section should be equal to or greater than the support span. Splices are ideally located at quarter-span points. Use appropriate clamps or threaded rods for hanging trays from beams, ensuring sufficient engagement for load ratings. Adjustable hangers are recommended for ceiling installations to accommodate different heights and angles. Regularly spaced supports prevent sagging and enhance system stability .

Alignment and Fastening

Mark tray positions using a measuring tape and level to ensure even alignment. Drill holes for mounting brackets and attach trays securely. Tighten fasteners to eliminate movement and maintain a stable setup. Install trays section by section, securing each before proceeding to the next. Use cable ties or clamps to prevent cables from shifting during operation. Verify alignment with a spirit level and adjust as necessary .

Safety and Maintenance



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Follow torque specifications (typically 3-4 ft.-lbs. for threaded rod nuts) and adhere to NEMA FG-1 guidelines for fittings. Ensure that cables installed are approved for tray use, and avoid overloading trays. Regular inspections and maintenance help maintain efficiency, prevent sagging, and extend the service life of the cable system .
