 - o Screw-On Covers: Align the cover and secure it with screws provided, ensuring a tight fit to prevent dust ingress .
 - o Non-Drill or Snap-On Covers: Use adhesive or snap mechanisms for decorative or temporary covers without damaging walls .
- o Check Accessibility: The cover must be removable without damage to allow future inspection, maintenance, or upgrades .

Safety Considerations

- o Use non-combustible or fire-rated materials to prevent fire hazards .
- o Ensure the cover does not obstruct ventilation or access to breakers and fuses .

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o Avoid permanent sealing or plastering over the cover, as this violates electrical codes .

Regularly inspect the cover for dust accumulation, cracks, or loose fittings. Clean with a dry cloth and ensure screws or snap mechanisms remain secure to maintain protection and safety .
