- o **Port Speeds:** Place faster switches closer to high-demand devices like NAS or servers.
- o **Mixed Switches:** If combining switches with different speeds (e.g., 10/100 Mbps and 1 Gbps), slower switches should be positioned at the network edge .
- o **IP Management:** Each switch may have its own IP address for management, especially in cascaded setups .
- o **Redundancy:** Using multiple links or trunking can provide failover in case one connection fails . By connecting switches properly, you can expand your network, improve device connectivity, and optimize data flow while maintaining efficient network management.
