Overview of Fiber Optic Splicing

Fiber optic splicing is the process of joining two fiber optic cables to create a continuous optical path. This is essential when cable runs exceed standard lengths, when repairing damaged cables, or when connecting different types of fiber cables. There are two main splicing methods:

- o Mechanical Splicing: Uses an alignment device and index-matching gel to hold fibers together. It is quick, temporary, and typically has a light loss of around 0.3 dB .
- o Fusion Splicing: Uses heat or an electric arc to permanently fuse glass ends, resulting in very low attenuation (~0.1 dB) and minimal back reflection. This method is preferred for long-term installations . Splicing requires precision tools such as cleavers, fusion splicers, OTDRs, light sources, and power meters to ensure low-loss connections and proper testing .
