Main Power Entry and Distribution

Start by connecting the incoming three-phase supply (R, Y, B, and Neutral) to the main breaker switch, which serves as the primary isolation point for maintenance or emergencies . From the main breaker, connect the output to a busbar system, which acts as a common distribution point for phase, neutral, and earth conductors. The busbar allows efficient distribution to multiple components requiring single-phase or three-phase power .

Circuit Breakers and Load Distribution

Individual circuit breakers are connected to the busbar outputs. Each breaker powers specific loads such as contactors, relays, or motor starters. This setup ensures controlled distribution and protection for each circuit . Avoid looping three-phase wires directly to multiple components, as this can cause damage or unsafe conditions .

PLC Input/Output Wiring

For digital inputs, connect the PLC common according to sink or source wiring. For example, if the common is 24V, connect 0V to all field inputs via terminal blocks. Each input wire is then connected to the corresponding PLC digital input terminal . For digital outputs, connect the PLC output and common to relays or actuators, ensuring the correct voltage type (AC or DC) is applied. Relay outputs can then control contactors or other devices, completing the circuit . Analog inputs and outputs are routed through terminal blocks directly to the PLC, preferably using fused terminal boards for additional safety .

Safety and Grounding

- o Earthing: Ground all components at a single point to reduce electrical noise and ensure safety .
- o Fuses and protection devices: Use fuses or circuit breakers for each critical circuit to prevent overloads .
- o Emergency stops: Include e-stop buttons and safety interlocks to comply with industrial safety standards .

Best Practices

- o Use color-coded, ferruled, and properly sized wires to simplify troubleshooting and maintenance .
- o Maintain clear labeling and schematics for all connections to facilitate future upgrades or repairs .
- o Plan for modular expansion, allowing additional PLC modules or I/O points without major rewiring .
