

Price of a broken distribution box

Septic Distribution Box (D-box)

A septic distribution box distributes wastewater from the septic tank to the drain field. Replacement costs generally range from \$600 to \$2,000, which includes the box itself (\$50-\$400), labor (\$500-\$1,300), and permits (\$50-\$300) depending on local regulations and material choice .

- o Standard home replacement: \$1,200-\$2,500 for a 100-125A indoor panel .
- o High-capacity or outdoor upgrades: \$3,000-\$6,000 for a 200A outdoor panel with new meter socket .
- o Subpanels: \$400-\$2,000 depending on size and complexity .
- o Circuit breakers or meter boxes: Individual components can cost \$5-\$650, but total labor-inclusive replacement is usually \$100-\$200 for breakers and \$1,000-\$3,000 if relocation is required .
