Common Grounding Methods

o Dedicated Grounding Screw or Clip

- o A copper or brass grounding screw connects the metal door to the cabinet's grounding bar.

o Grounding Kits

- o Pre-packaged kits include screws, straps, and bonding devices for enclosure doors.
- o Ensures consistent grounding and simplifies installation.
- o Cost: \$30-\$100 per kit, depending on kit complexity and enclosure size .

Factors Affecting Cost

- o Material: Copper components are more expensive than aluminum or steel.
- o Enclosure Type: Stainless steel enclosures may require anti-corrosion treatments or conductive paste, slightly increasing cost .
- o Installation: Hiring a qualified electrician may add \$50-\$150 per hour depending on local labor rates.
- o Environment: Hazardous locations (chemical plants, grain silos) may require explosion-proof grounding methods, increasing cost.
