Mechanical Bending

The welded mesh panels are then mechanically bent into the U-shaped tray profile using specialized bending machines. The process involves:

- o Loading the flat mesh panel onto the lower die.
- o Aligning the mesh along the bend line.
- o Applying pressure with a V-shaped upper die to bend one side.
- o Repositioning and bending the opposite side to complete the tray profile .

Surface Treatment

After forming, trays undergo surface treatments such as galvanization or powder coating to protect against corrosion, especially for outdoor or industrial environments .
