o When submitting a quotation or tender response, include technical specifications, installation plan, maintenance schedule, and compliance with Turkmenistan's energy regulations. This increases the likelihood of approval and competitive evaluation.

o Request Formal Quotations

o Reach out to multiple suppliers with a detailed Request for Quotation (RFQ) specifying:

o System capacity: 20kW

o Type: Grid-tied, off-grid, or hybrid

o Components: Inverters, controllers, monitoring software

o Installation and commissioning

o Warranty and maintenance terms
