Bracket and Fixing Requirements

- o **Firm and Reliable Mounting:** Distribution boxes should be securely fixed to prevent movement, tilting, or vibration damage. Suitable mounting brackets, screws, or channels should be used to ensure stability, especially in industrial or high-traffic areas .
- o **Height Considerations:** The bottom edge of the distribution box is typically installed 1.2-1.8 meters above the ground, depending on operational convenience and safety . Brackets should support this height while allowing easy access for inspection and operation.
- o **Material and Durability:** Brackets should be made of non-combustible, corrosion-resistant materials, such as galvanized steel, to withstand environmental conditions and prevent rusting . For outdoor or harsh environments, brackets must support enclosures with IP ratings (e.g., IP-55) and reinforced structures .
- o **Environmental Adaptation:** Avoid installing brackets in humid, corrosive, or flammable environments unless using explosion-proof or specially treated brackets and enclosures . Brackets should allow proper ventilation and heat dissipation to prevent overheating.
- o **Clearance and Accessibility:** Ensure 0.8-1.2 meters of unobstructed space in front of the box for safe operation. Brackets should maintain this clearance and allow for neat cable routing and component access .

Additional Considerations

- o **Grounding and Safety:** Brackets must not interfere with grounding connections. The metal box, electrical components, and brackets should be properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards .
- o **Load Support:** Brackets should be capable of supporting the weight of the fully loaded distribution box, including breakers, busbars, and wiring, without deformation or risk of detachment .
- o **Compliance:** Installation should follow IEC, NEC, or local electrical codes, and brackets should be compatible with certified enclosures and components . By following these requirements, distribution box brackets will ensure safe, durable, and code-compliant installation, minimizing risks of electrical faults, mechanical failure, or environmental damage.
