- o Enclosure: Typically made of metal or durable thermoplastics, it protects internal components from physical damage and prevents accidental contact with live parts .

Functions

- o Power Distribution: Divides incoming electricity into multiple circuits for lighting, outlets, appliances, and equipment .
- o Circuit Protection: Prevents damage from overloads, short circuits, or electrical faults by tripping breakers or blowing fuses .
- o Monitoring and Maintenance: Modern DB boxes may include smart features for energy monitoring, remote control, and quick identification of faulty circuits .
- o Safety Compliance: Ensures adherence to electrical codes and standards, reducing fire risks and protecting users .

Types

- o Residential Load Centers: Common in homes, usually with plug-in breakers.
- o Commercial/Industrial Panelboards: Often use bolt-on breakers and may include advanced monitoring systems .

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o Smart Distribution Boxes: Equipped with energy management units and communication modules for automation and real-time monitoring .
