

Shopping Mall Cable Tray Dimensions

Standard cable tray widths for commercial buildings like shopping malls typically range from 50mm to 900mm, with depths from 25mm to 150mm and lengths of 3 meters per section.

Standard Dimensions

Cable trays in shopping malls are designed to accommodate varying numbers of power, data, and communication cables while ensuring proper ventilation and safety. Typical dimensions include:

- o Width: 50mm to 900mm, depending on cable volume and type . Small trays (50-100mm) are used for light data cables, while wider trays (up to 900mm) support heavy power cables or large bundles .
- o Depth/Height: 25mm to 150mm, with deeper trays (75-150mm) preferred for thick or heavy power cables to prevent sagging and overheating .
- o Length: Standard sections are usually 3 meters (10 feet), which allows easy transport and modular installation .
- o Material Thickness: Varies by load capacity and material; heavy-duty trays often require 2.5mm or more thickness with reinforced side rails for structural support .

Tray Types

Different tray types are used depending on cable type, load, and installation environment:

- o Ladder Tray: Ideal for heavy power cables; prioritizes width, side rail height, and thickness for load-bearing .
- o Perforated Tray: Provides ventilation for heat dissipation; suitable for mixed cable types .
- o Wire Mesh (Basket) Tray: Lightweight and flexible; commonly used for data and fiber optic cables in areas requiring frequent changes .
- o Channel Tray: Compact, U-shaped; best for light-duty applications or tight spaces .

Sizing Considerations

Proper sizing ensures safety, compliance, and future expandability:

- o Calculate Cable Area: Measure the outside diameter of each cable, not just conductor size .
- o Determine Tray Fill: NEC and IEC standards typically limit tray fill to a percentage of usable area (commonly 40%) to allow ventilation and prevent overheating .
- o Select Tray Width and Depth: Use the formula: $\text{Required Tray Area} = \text{Total Cable Area} / \text{Allowed Fill Percentage}$ Then choose a tray width and depth that meets or exceeds this area .
- o Future Expansion: Consider additional capacity for future cable additions to avoid costly retrofits .

- o Use ladder or perforated trays for power cables to ensure heat dissipation.
- o Use wire mesh trays for data and fiber optic cables to allow flexibility and easy maintenance.
- o Ensure constant support along the tray to prevent sagging, especially for long runs.
