Distribution box sockets include M12, Schuko, and UTE types, with specifications varying by slot number, coding, connection method, and status indicators.

Common Socket Types

1. M12 Sockets

- o Application: Standard industrial distributor boxes for sensor/actuator connections.
- o Connection Methods: Screw connection, push-pull female connector, or fixed plug-in connection.
- o Slots and Positions: Typically 8 slots with 4 or 5 positions per slot.
- o Coding: A-coded for standardization.
- o Status Display: Available with PNP indicators or without status display.
- o Master Cable Connection: Pluggable screw connection or push-in spring connection at 180° orientation.
- o Materials: Plastic housings, PUR/PVC cables, optional shielding.
- o Cable Lengths: Standard lengths include 1 m, 2 m, 3 m, 5 m, and 10 m.

2. Schuko/UTE Sockets

- o Application: Power distribution units (PDUs) in distribution boxes for AC power supply.
- o Features: Designed to safely distribute electricity from a power source to devices in a circuit.
- o Installation: Can be mounted in standard enclosures; modifications outside recommended areas may require additional engineering.
- o Compliance: Typically follow local electrical standards for safety and grounding.

Industrial Enclosure Specifications

- o IP Ratings: IP55, IP65, IP66 depending on model, ensuring protection against dust and water ingress.
- o IK Ratings: IK07 to IK10 for impact resistance.
- o Materials: Polycarbonate, polypropylene, PVC, polystyrene, stainless steel (304L), or GRP for weatherproof applications.
- o Mounting Options: Wall-mounted, free-standing, reversible doors, and optional heavy-duty brackets.
- o Additional Features: Lockable doors, sealable covers, optimized cable runs, and internal mounting plates for modular components.

Key Considerations

- o Slot Assignment: Single or double assignment depending on the number of devices connected.
- o Status Indicators: PNP or NPN indicators provide visual feedback for signal presence.
- o Compatibility: Ensure socket type matches the connector coding and voltage/current requirements.
