Ensure trays are aligned, level, and straight, using connectors and fittings to join sections. For long runs, use cable tray rollers to prevent kinks and maintain smooth cable laying ().

Cable Laying and Organization

Lay cables neatly, separating them by voltage and function. Use cable ties or straps to maintain organization and leave slack for expansion or future adjustments (). Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the tray to avoid damage ().

Grounding and Bonding

Metal trays must be properly grounded and bonded. Use bonding jumpers across tray sections to maintain electrical continuity and comply with safety standards ().
